

2014 Legislative Agenda

Top Two Issues

- 1. Preventing Gun Violence (Initiative 594- will be going to the legislature)
- Preventing Wage Theft (this bill from last session will be broken into four separate bills, they are misclassification, retaliation, wage lien, and treble damages)

Additional Issues

- 1. Creating Sufficient Revenue for the State Budget
 - a. Eliminating Tax Exemptions
 - b. Creating more Transparency and Accountability
- 2. Preserving our State's Safety Net
 - a. Hunger Issues (Budget Requests)
 - i. \$1 million for EFAP (Emergency Feeding Assistance Program) i.e. our state's food banks.
 - ii. \$500k for Women/Infant/Children/Senior Farmer Market NutritionProgram (\$300k for WIC, \$200k Seniors)
 - iii. \$4.5 million for the State Food Assistance Program (This is primarily for legal immigrants)
 - b. Poverty Issues
 - i. Preventing any bad payday lending bills
- 3. Dismantling the Culture of Violence
 - a. Criminal Justice Reforms
 - i. 2nd Chance Act (Rep. Roberts and Rep. Goodman)
 - ii. Higher Education in Prisons Bill (Rep. Seaquist HB 1429) this will lift the current prohibition.
 - iii. Re-Entry (Sealing juvenile records as a way to remove the barrier to housing and employment)
 - iv. Abolish Death Penalty
- 4. Support Passage of the State DREAM Act
