- Eastside's first permanent supportive housing that opened mid-July in Bellevue, focusing on homelessness resources and affordable housing;
- part of the new 10-acre Eastgate Housing Campus that includes CFH (now Porchlight)
   permanent men's shelter and the 353-unit Polaris at Eastgate affordable housing
   development. www.https://plymouthhousing.org
- Does not do shelter work or medication management. Five case managers onsite. Twenty-four hour front desk staff. Working towards onsite nursing and onsite social worker. They are open to single adults, tend to be older and long-term housing-challenged. Building rules that tenants are expected to abide by. Secure residence.
- Connect residents to services such as case management, transportation.

- Looking for organizations to engage with. Need donations of hygiene products, shelf stable foods, games/activities, premade lunches; volunteer to prepare and serve a meal, host a bingo night, BBQ on the patio;
