¹ **Congregations for Kids** - Congregations for Kids - This coalition of local congregations, helped by Eastside businesses and community organizations, provides backpacks and/or school supplies annually for students from low-income families within the Bellevue School District. This school year C4K is helping around 2600 students with backpacks and school supplies for home use since the district is now providing supplies in the classroom. Led by volunteers, C4K is the only organization in Bellevue to provide these for students in kindergarten through high school whom the district determines need them the most. Since Congregations for Kids' first Good Start Back to School project in 1996, over 39,950 requests from the district have been filled. www.congregations4kids.org
